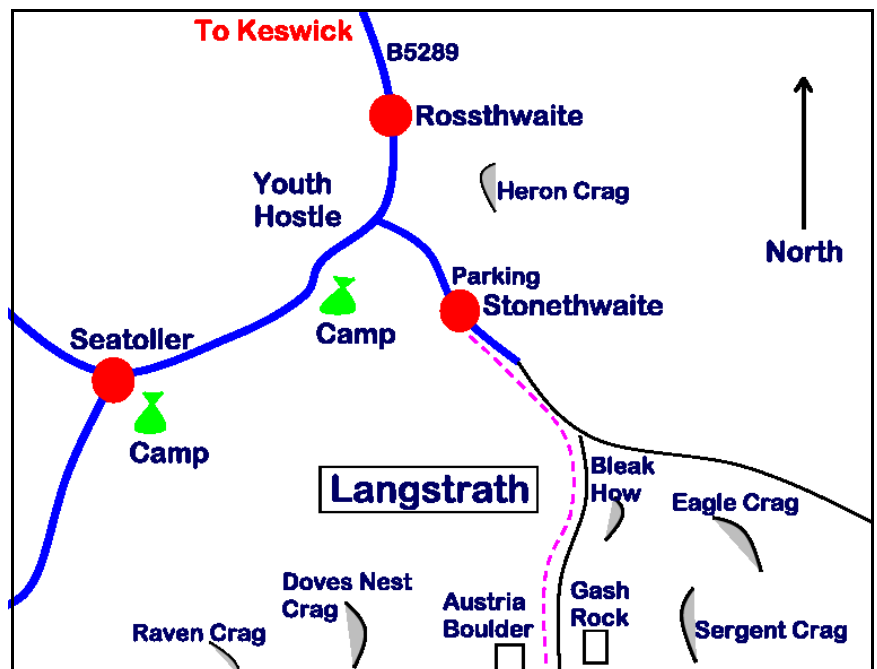

Approach

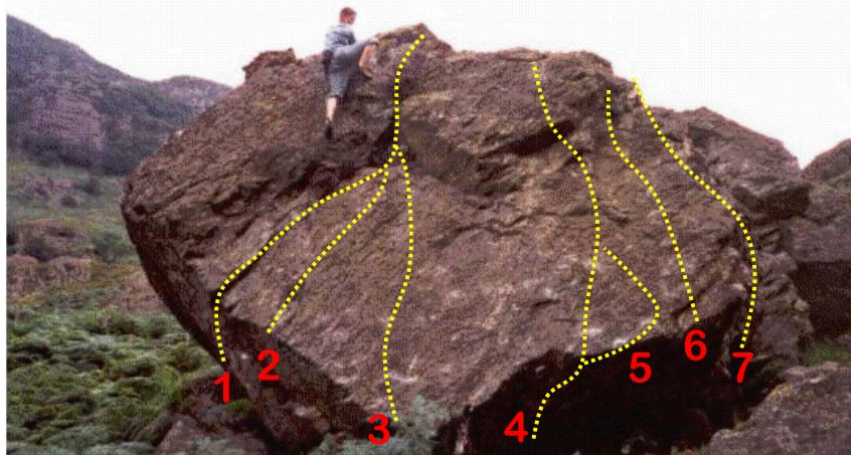
The Austria boulder and the other boulders in the Langstrath valley make a smart little venue with a couple of classic test pieces in a beautiful setting.

The boulders are a 30 minute walk from Stonethwaite campsite and make an excellent half day circuit.

There are also a number of projects still to do so don't say we didn't tell you.



The Austria Boulder



1. V1 - The Crack to then to the top.
2. V1 - The slab.
3. No Pain No Gain V6 - (Sit start) Start at the boulders lowest point and climb direct to the boulders highest point. *
4. Eat Yourself Whole V8 - (Sit start) From the hand rail below the small roof (left of a foot stone) up direct. **
5. Right Hand Variant V6 - (Sit start as a above but move right to a boss to avoid the initial difficulties.

6. V1 - Slab and groove.
7. V0 - Arête.

The Other Boulders.

To the right of the Austria Boulder is another boulder with a highball V7 steep wall and a good V2 highball arête which is right again.

Down left of the Austria is the Liechtenstein area with a couple more blocks, the right of which has a nice V4 slab.
